Can you help the Pagham Ponies?



Pagham Ponies is a horse and pony sanctuary based in Pagham, West Sussex. There are currently 11 ponies and horses and all have been rescued from varying levels of neglect, cruelty or illness. With the help of trustees they have applied for charitable status in order to give greater security and support to the animals at the sanctuary and are trying to raise a minimum of £5000 in order to be given a charity number.

Every penny raised will go directly on the animals, on the food, sanctuary, veterinary, dentistry and farrier bills. Pagham Ponies are hoping to arrange several different fund raising events to help to raise the money and any one-off or regular donations would be very much appreciated. You may see our collection boxes in local pet stores; please give what you are able to afford, every penny will go towards supporting our horses, ponies and shetlands.

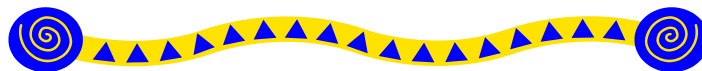
