Expressive Arts and Design



- I can begin to draw and paint people, places and objects and add features.
- I can use a range of media e.g. pencils, paints, chalk pastels to create collages and pictures.
- I can take part in imaginative play.
- I can explore what happens when colours are mixed together.
- I can use my imagination to create junk models using boxes, tubes, cartons etc.
- I can sing Christmas songs.
