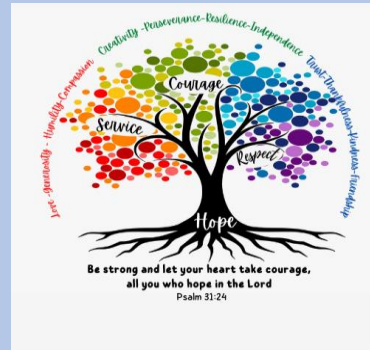
Head Teacher Message
