- 2. Google classroom is monitored by the school, but it is everyone's responsibility to ensure that it is used correctly. If you see something that makes you uncomfortable, then it is your duty to report it to your class teacher and the school office.
- 3. Children's email addresses, password and class codes are not to be shared with anyone else. If you are having issues accessing Google classroom, please get in contact with the school office or with your class teacher via ClassDojo.
- 4. It is parental responsibility to ensure consistent access to google classroom, so online learning can occur. If you have difficulties providing that consistent access, then please get in touch with the school, where we will be happy to help.

Things to remember:

Your child may be part of more than one classroom, they may have a classroom for Maths, a separate classroom for English etc. If you think your child doesn't have access to something, then please get in touch with the class teacher.

Google classroom stream is like Facebook, in that everyone can see what you have posted within the classroom. It's a constant news feed and at times things can get missed on there.
