Your child's Flu vaccination is now due!

The Immunisation Service are coming into school on **Thursday 23/10/2025** to offer your child the **nasal Flu spray vaccination**.

Please complete a consent form for your child to say YES or NO for them to have these vaccines.

This must be completed by a Parent or Legal Guardian with Parental Responsibility

Follow the steps below, **before the closing date and time**, which is at 11 am, 2 working days before the school session date above. If you miss the cut off time, the consent form will reopen one working day after the session, enabling you to submit a form for your child to be offered the vaccination within one of our catch-up clinics.

2. Enter the following school code **SX126024** and click 'Find School' - *School codes are unique to each school and site.*

If you have any questions or need support to complete the consent form, please contact our friendly team: 01273 696011 x8100

We may contact you if we do not receive either a YES or NO consent, to ask for your consent preference. If your child presents themselves to the Immunisation Team during the school session to request vaccination, we may offer them the opportunity to consent for themselves. (Details in the FAQs).

Please note the immunisation team may contact you by email, phone or text if there are any medical queries on the submitted consent form.
