



Topic: Going Up, Coming Down (Part 2)

<p>English</p>	<p>Read a range of traditional tales. Think about the 'baddies' in each story. Compare these characters. What do they have in common? You could draw these characters or even create your own evil character!</p>	<p>Watch you tube clips about trawlermen and write key words ready for our writing sessions. Talk to your adults about what it must be like to be a trawlerman. NB please view all clips prior to children watching them.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Use coins to make different amounts of money. How many different ways can you make the same amount? What is the best way? What is the worst way? Focus on number formation.</p>	<p>Draw a timetable of the day. Write down what you do at different times of the day and learn to read the time on an analogue clock. Think about our class visual timetable. Where is the minute hand at half past? Where is the minute hand at quarter past? Where is the minute hand at quarter to?</p>
<p>Science/ History/ Geography</p>	<p>Find out about a boat from the past that had an adventure. What was it called? Where did it travel to? Who was on it?
