English	Go to your local library and choose books about dinosaurs. Share these books with someone at home. Take a photo of you sharing the book and send it to us via Class Dojo.	Can you make a glossary of ten (or more!) tricky words related to our dinosaur topic? Remember to include the definitions. You could draw pictures to go with your words to help you remember them.
Maths	Can you do some dinosaur-themed cooking/baking? Perhaps you could make some dinosaur shaped biscuits or some dinosaur cupcakes? Can you write the ingredients list using numbers and grams? Can you read out your quantities of ingredients when cooking/baking? <i>*Only carry out this activity with close adult supervision.</i> 	<u>Dino Maths Challenge</u> (You may like to use counters or small objects to represent the eggs): * 3 dinosaurs laid some eggs * They each laid an ODD number of eggs * All together they laid 19 eggs How many eggs did each dinosaur lay, and how many different solutions can you find? Bring in your solutions and show the class!
Science	Use sticks, cotton buds or dowling to create a skeleton of your favourite dinosaur. Think carefully about the length of the legs and neck. What could you use to make the teeth? Depending on the size of the skeleton, either bring it to school to share or take a photo. 	Group a range of dinosaurs in different ways. What is the same about them? What is different? You could think about their skin/scales or feathers, where they lived, what they ate or who ate them!
Creative Arts	Make your own dinosaur themed game. It could be a snakes and ladders style game or a board game where you have to answer questions about dinosaurs!	Make a dinosaur habitat using materials you can find at home.
