

## Pupils Premium Statement 2020/21

The pupil premium grant is funding provided to school in addition to main school funding. It is awarded on the basis of the number of children eligible for free school meals (FSM), those who have been eligible for FSM in the past six years, pupils who have been adopted from care under the Adoption and Children Act 2002 or who have left care under a Special Guardianship or Residential order, and children who are designated as CLA (Looked after children) for more than six months. A smaller amount of funding is allocated for pupils from service families.

The government believes that it is for schools to decide how the Pupils Premium Grant is spent as we are best placed to assess the necessary provision to support pupils and families. However, we are rightly held accountable for how we have used the additional funding.

Our priority for the academic year 2020/21 is narrowing the gap for those pupils in any year group who are achieving below their peers. It is recognised and agreed that these are the 'target' pupils but that other pupils will also benefit from the improvements in provision. The majority of funding is planned to be used in this way, and we also plan to use some funding to ensure that all pupils are able to access the curriculum and are ready to learn.
