Dear Parents,

Thank you all for so quickly engaging and supporting your children with the Remote Learning during this tricky transition. As the government has stated, remote learning will be in place at least up until February Half term, so I wanted to give further details regarding our Remote Learning Provision going forward.

Google Classroom:

Following on from what the teachers provided this week, from Monday, the remote learning arrangements, all through Google Classroom, will include:

- Weekly Suggested Timetable to support you in structuring your learning day.
- There will be a message from the class teacher each day: either a video or written message.
- Daily lessons in Literacy, Mathematics and another area of learning will be provided daily. Each lesson will be posted as an Assignment on Google Classrooms. (This may look different for Farrant class EYFS)
- We would encourage your child to read daily. Links to digital reading platforms, where you can access e-books for your children will be shared with you.
- Your child's teacher will communicate with you a dedicated weekly time for a Keep in touch live video session which your child can join if they choose.

The same high expectations of neatness and presentation are required in work. Please submit photos of completed learning on Google Classroom so your child's teacher can look at what has been completed and give feedback.

Teachers will be responding to work and answering any questions during the afternoons.

This is a new way of learning and there may be teething troubles to begin with, but hopefully you will soon be able to get into the swing of things. Please continue to refer to the Parent Guide to Google Classrooms as you familiarise yourself with the platform.

Paper Packs of Work:

If you are finding it difficult to access the work online, and would prefer a paper pack of the key work from the week, these will be available for you to collect from the school office from 9:15 Every Monday Morning. Please ring the school office to notify Mrs Mott before you travel.

Note books:

We are also offering you the chance to collect a school work book in which to complete work. For KS2, this will be one maths note book and one literacy/project book. For KS1, this will be one book for all work. If this is something you would benefit from, please collect from the school office during the specified windows:
